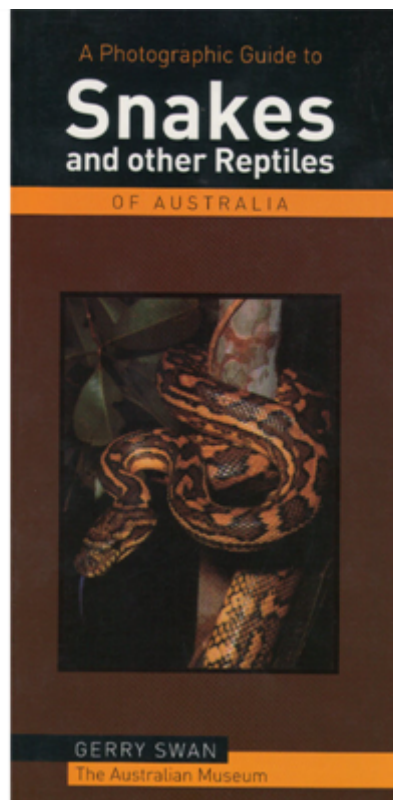

There are at least 19 large mammal and 96 small mammal species known to occur in Montana. [1] Among Montana's mammals, three are listed as endangered or threatened.
